

KANSAS CITY METRO APPROVES ADS AND HANCOR HDPE PIPE FOR STORM SEWER APPLICATIONS



Overland Park Approval of HDPE for Private Storm Sewer

The Engineering Services Department of Overland Park, KS revised their Storm Sewer Specifications. The revision included an approval of high-density polyethylene (HDPE) pipe for private storm sewer application in 15" through 24" diameters for conveyance systems, and up to 60" for detention systems, using watertight joints. The watertight joints required by Overland Park is the best joint available in storm sewer pipe.

Approved HDPE materials must have passed the Plastic Pipe Institute (PPI) 3rd Party Certification Program or the National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP). ADS N-12[®] WT and Hancor BLUE SEAL[®] pipe exceeds the requirements for each of these programs. N-12 WT and BLUE SEAL have a smooth interior and can therefore take advantage of improved hydraulic efficiency. The outstanding durability of HDPE pipe results in maximum service life compared to corrugated metal pipe (CMP) and the costs of HDPE pipe systems are often significantly lower than those of reinforced concrete pipe (RCP).

Kansas City, KS/Wyandotte County Approval for use of HDPE Pipe for Storm Sewer Applications

The Public Works Department of Kansas City, Kansas/Wyandotte County reviewed the policy regarding HDPE pipe for storm sewer applications. HDPE pipe will be allowed under pavement in private parking lots and streets. HDPE pipe will also be allowed inside public right of way, and under local streets. HDPE will join RCP as the only approved products for public storm sewers.

City of Liberty Approves HDPE Storm Sewer Pipe

The City of Liberty approved the use of corrugated polyethylene pipe for storm sewer and culvert applications within the city. HDPE is allowed under local and subdivision streets, as well as behind the curb on higher volume roads. HDPE will join RCP and CMP as acceptable materials for use in storm sewer projects on new public infrastructure projects including new subdivisions as well as CIP work.
